This is Why We Go to the Subways...



He looked down and said a sentence, and all Mark got out of it was "mi corazón" (my heart) and "mi familia" (my family). Mark said, "Do you want me to pray for your heart for your family?" and he said, "si" (yes). Mark said, "Frances, I promise I will pray for you, your heart, and your family." He walked away with a Spanish gospel tract and said "gracias!" And he was smiling.

Here's a man having issues with his wife or kids or someone in his family, and he sees Mark, a stranger, but sees that he's handing out

literature about Jesus, and asks Mark to pray for him and his heart. He gets our prayers (and yours too please) and he receives the gospel message in his language!


